RCP dominant L bursting 0038-0206 UTC from 16 to 27 MHz, vertex late arcs, no modulation lanes visible.

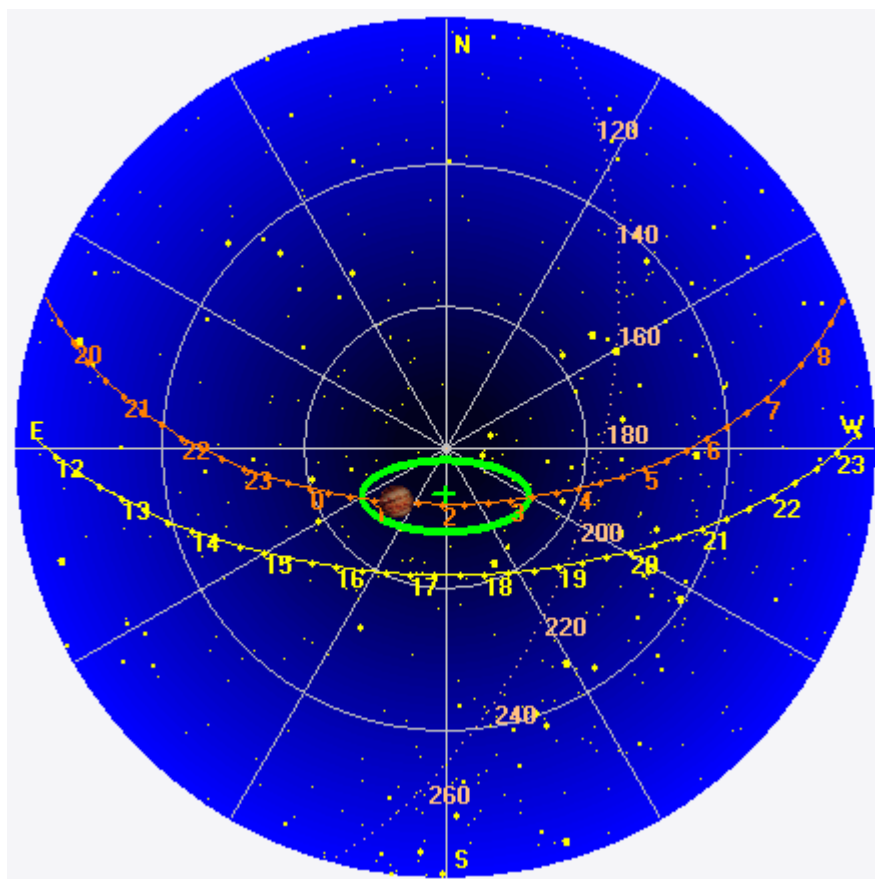
Jupiter was -20° to $+2^\circ$ off axis.

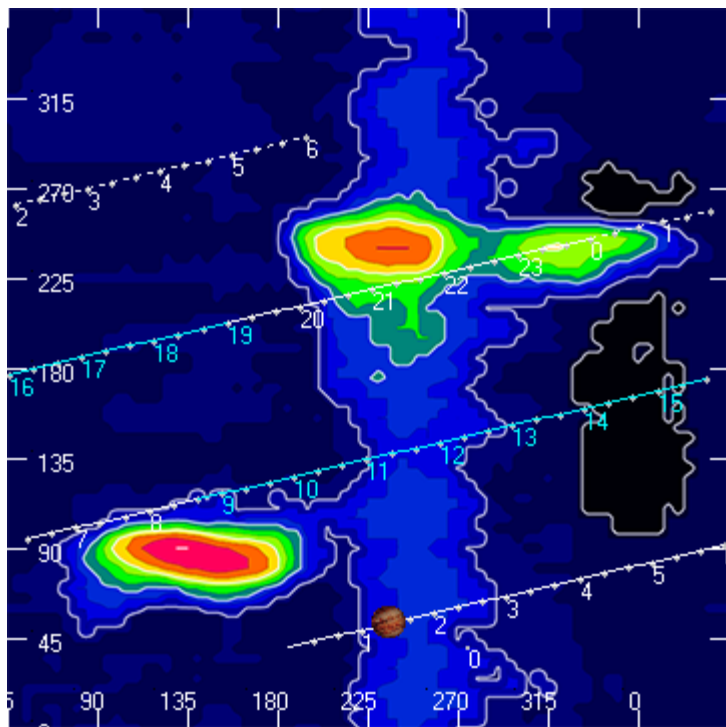
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 124° .

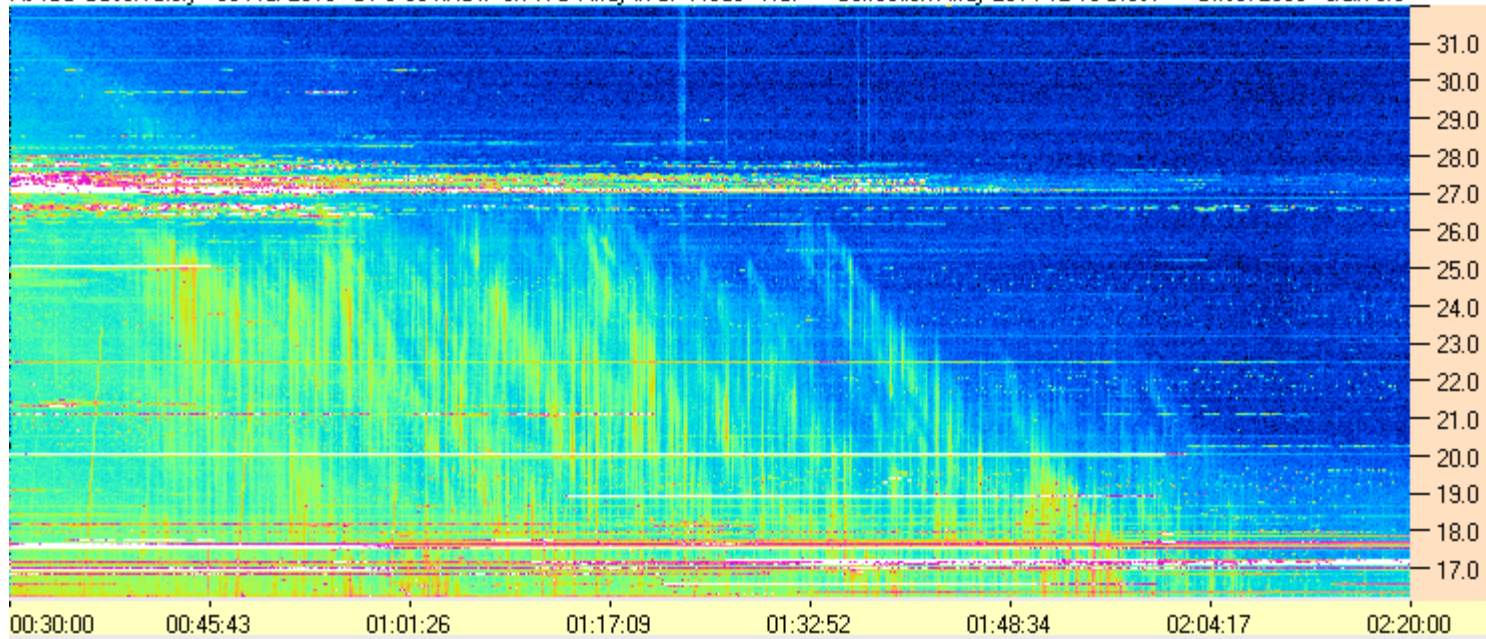
