RCP dominant L bursting 2247 - 2314 UTC from 18 to 26 MHz, downward drifting arcs. No modulation lanes visible.

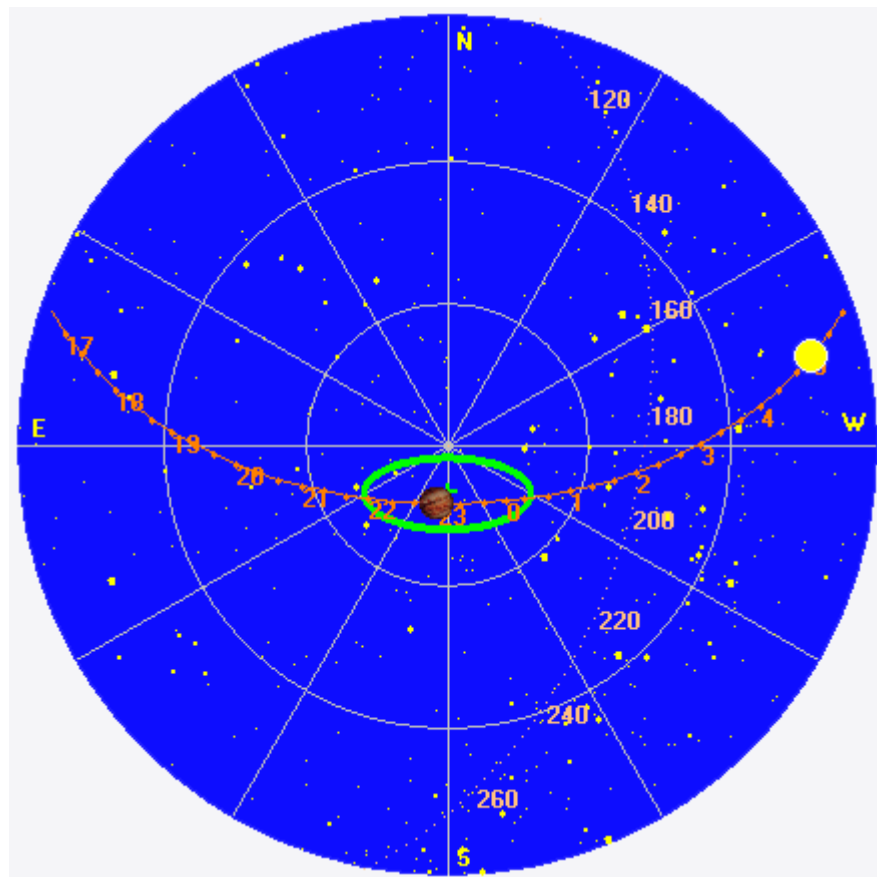
Jupiter was -6° to $+3^\circ$ off axis.

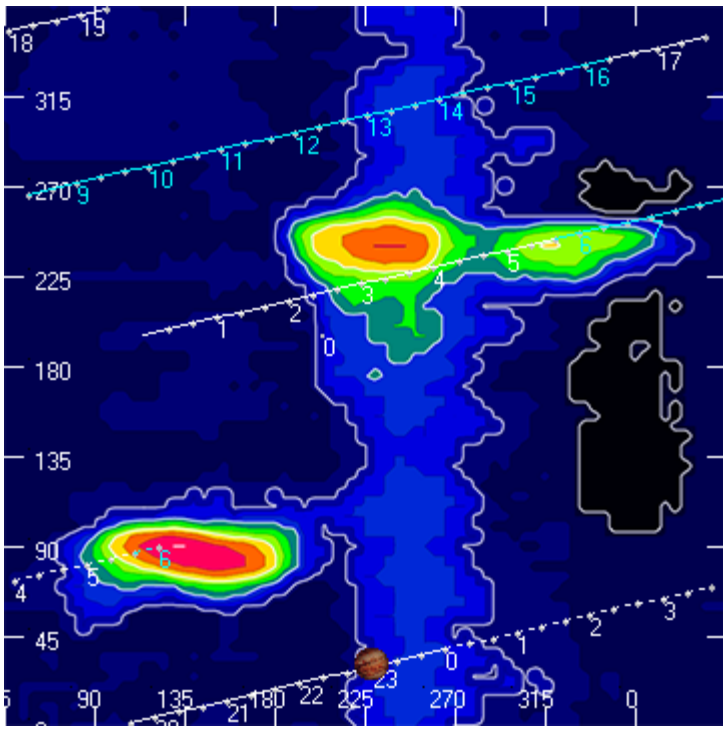
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 81° .

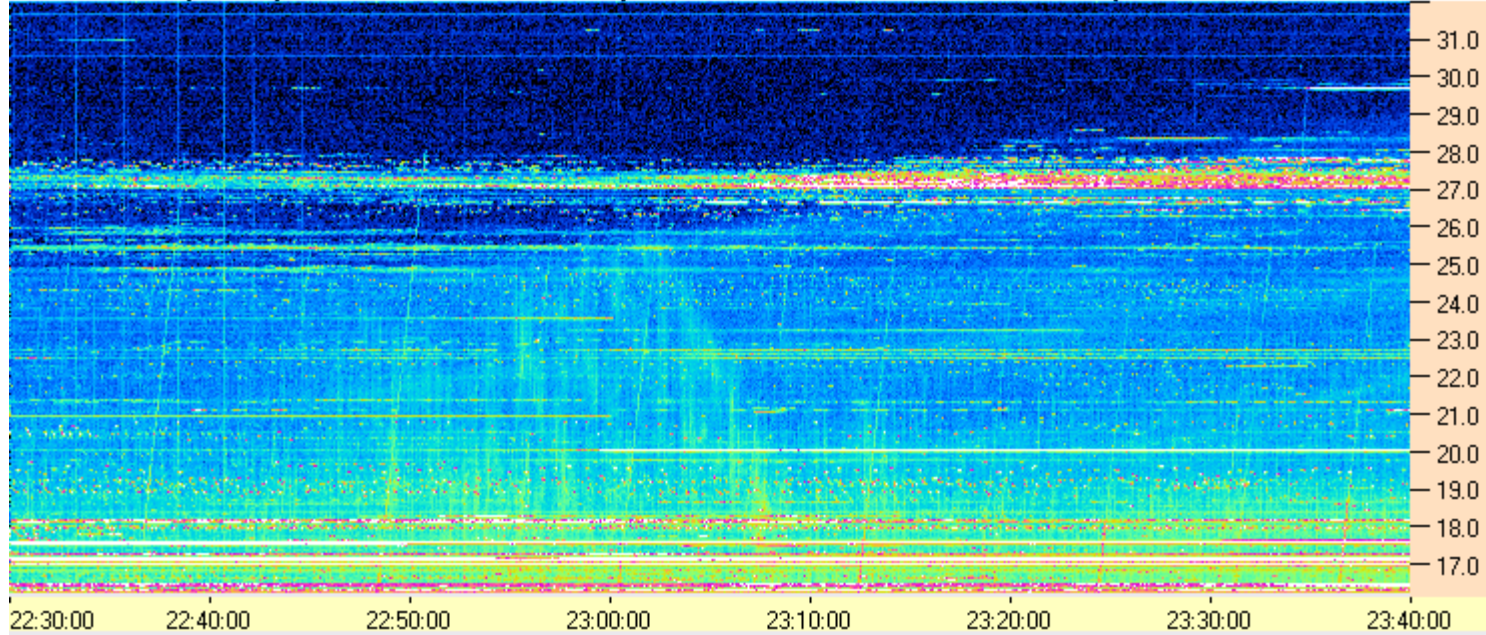
